

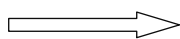
Seminar and Reading Course on Economic Policy

For seminar participants:	Attend <u>all</u> meetings (reading course & seminar)! Present the progress report in the Progress Report Meeting (participation is obligatory). Write a research paper (about 15 - 20 pages) to be handed in by Monday, November 30, 12.00 a.m. in room 2513. Present the paper at the Block-Seminar. Active participation in the discussion of other papers.
For reading course participants:	Attend <u>all</u> meetings (reading course & seminar)! To receive 4 credits it is necessary to pass an exam (exam covers material from the lectures and the seminar). A repeat exam is offered.
